Councillor Hugill discussed what has happened within Hambleton District and County over the past year. Councillor Hugill explained that £141M worth of savings had been made against a target of £186M. He reported that they are still having to make money saving decisions but NYCC won't go into special measures like some councils.

Councillor Hugill reported that while pot holes are an issue 96% of North Yorkshires roads are in good condition.

He thanked the council for making him feel welcome.
